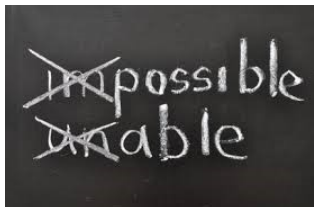

CCS has learned that volunteer positions with non-profit organizations typically do not lead to paid employment down the road. Their success rate has only been 15% so far. They have learned that “carving” positions is much more effective.
